

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Your enthusiasm will help to ensure the success of this project! The contest information should be posted for students and also announced whenever possible. Constant encouragement and frequent reminders of the contest will be crucial.
- Discuss characteristics of a “good” poster, essay, or song with students. It is a great asset to utilize your art, English, and music teachers! Posters should not be too crowded or busy. An effective design will catch one’s eye and convey the message quickly. The right sized lettering with few words is important. Bright and contrasting colors are also recommended.
- The “theme” of the submission is important and may be a tricky concept to convey to the students. The idea should interpret the student’s vision of sexual abstinence in a positive manner. Any inappropriate messages, drawings, or ideas will be disqualified. Try to clarify this for students from the beginning.
- The project may be done as an in-class assignment, or as an optional or required home assignment, as long as it can be verified that it is original student work.
- All contest rules must be strictly followed. Failure to do so will subject the entry to disqualification.
- All entry forms must be completed entirely and verified by the submitting teacher or campus coordinator. Your signature serves as confirmation of the originality of the student’s art. Copyright laws apply.
- Entry forms may be photocopied as needed. Individuals participating in a music group must each complete an entry form.
- **NO student information should appear on the front of art or literary work or in the music entry. Any signatures or initials will cause disqualification.**
- Music tapes or discs should be labeled with the group name or individual’s initials.
- Non-grant entries must be signed by the teacher who is responsible for Scott & White Worth the Wait® curriculum instruction.
- All entries should be postmarked by May 31, 2007. Late entries will not be accepted.

- Judging will be completed during the summer break 2007. Announcements and award presentations will be made early in the 2007-2008 school year. Winners will be listed on our website.
